The costumes may reflect region and sometimes social or marital status.




FAMOUS PEOPLE




John Paul II was the first Pole and Slav to become a Roman Catholic Pope. He held the papacy between 1978 and 2005.

Robert Lewandowski is a Polish professional footballer who plays as a striker for the German club Bayern Munich, and captain of Polish national team.


MAŁOPOLSKA VOIVODESHIP


